



AutoCharge : PAYG

On-street and Car Park EV Charging

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

It is recommended that this AutoCharge : PAYG unit be installed by a competent electrician in accordance with BS7671 and the IET Code of Practice

Before fitting you need to be sure you have sufficient GSM signal to transmit data to and from the pedestal

This AutoCharge pedestal requires a ground mounting base to be installed into the ground unless the unit is being fitted with expansion bolts into preformed concrete or other suitable hard surface. Refer to the Ground Mounting Base (GMB) fitting instructions that accompany the GMB, these are available through your supplier, and fit the mounting base before installation.

1. Check the contents of the packaging ensuring that the unit is undamaged.
2. Establish a suitable location for mounting the AutoCharge pedestal in association with the electric vehicle's parked charging location. Remember to allow room for plug connectors and cable management brackets (if fitted) on one or more sides of the finished unit.
3. Remove the AutoCharge pedestal from its protective packaging.
4. Using the access key supplied, remove the AutoCharge pedestal front cover and place safely to one side during installation.
5. Feed the power supply cable up through the opening in the base of the AutoCharge pedestal whilst lowering the pedestal onto the GMB in its desired position. Please note that in certain circumstances there may be Ethernet or other communications cables routed to or from the unit depending on model and type.
6. Tighten down the nuts on the studs protruding through the base plate from the GMB.
7. Connect the supply/earth cable to the gland plate and terminals in accordance with BS7671 and the IET code of practice.
8. On completion of electrical connections, check all other terminations and test.
9. Carefully re-fit the front cover to the base unit. Ensure that the earth wire is attached to the door and secure with the key supplied.
10. Test that communication is established for payment methods and charge times.
11. The unit is now ready to use.
